



# TRIBUTE TO CHIEF WESLEY DANIELS

The Prince Albert Grand Council honours the late Chief Wesley Ray Daniels by dedicating the 2014-2015 Annual report to his memory.

Chief Daniels was elected as Chief of Sturgeon Lake First Nation for seven terms. During this time he made positive contributions to the First Nations developments in the areas of economic development, education development, health services, Child and Family Services and Women's Rights. He played a key role in the successful negotiations of Sturgeon Lake First Nation specific and the treaty land entitlement claims.

He was an active member of many Prince Albert Grand Council boards and commissions. He was a long term member of the Board of Directors of Prince Albert Development Corporation as well as the Northern Spruce Housing Corporation.



Chief Daniels also served on numerous Federation of Saskatchewan Indian Nations boards and commissions. He was the first chairman of the National Aboriginal Minerals Association.

He was a strong advocate for Treaty rights throughout his life, a loved father and husband.

After years of dedicating his life to First Nations causes and developments, Chief Daniels succumbed to his illness on May 22, 2015 with his family by his side.
